The goal of this class is to develop the language skills and confidence needed to successfully pursue academic studies. You will expand your vocabulary and develop accurate grammar in speaking and writing. You will also gain advanced listening and reading skills.

During the class, you will develop portfolios of language study and learning. These portfolios will help you develop independent learning skills and will be used by the instructor to provide assessment and suggest further study.

Through a wide range of authentic material and course texts, you'll become familiar with the language used in topics common to academic texts and develop strategies for successful test taking.
